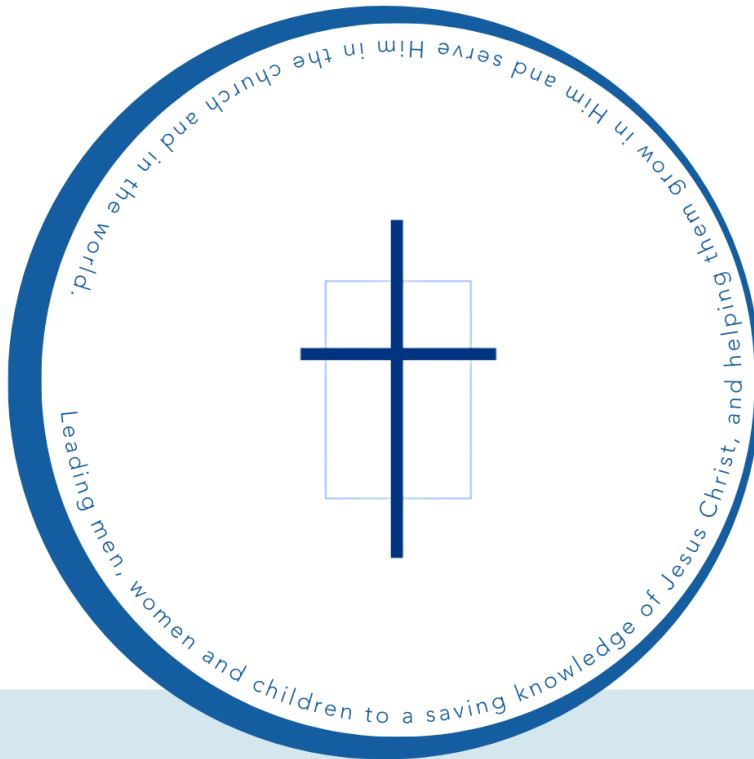

GOD CLEANSSES US
Within the context
of our relationship
with God, we are
invited in safety, not
shame, to consider
our sins. God loves
us despite our sins.
We rehearse this
truth each week by
confessing our sins
corporately and
leaning into his
renewal, restoration,
and cleansing.

All: According to the command of Christ: Those who, though called Christians, profess unchristian teachings or live unchristian lives, and after repeated and long counsel refuse to abandon their errors and wickedness, and after being reported to the church, that is, to its officers, fail to respond also to their admonition—such persons the officers exclude from the Christian fellowship by withholding the sacraments from them, and God himself excludes them from the kingdom of Christ. Such persons, when promising and demonstrating genuine reform, are received again as members of Christ and of his church.

CONFESSION OF SIN.....Based on James 3:13-18 & Daniel 9:19

Leader: With repentant hearts, let us now confess our sins together before the Lord:

All: O God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering and abounding in lovingkindness: we have sinned in subtle and significant ways. Our conduct has not always shown the meekness of wisdom. Rather, there have been seasons and times of bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in our hearts, which means we have boasted and been false to the truth. And with this jealousy and selfish ambition have come disorder and every vile practice. Forgive, Father, for Christ's sake. Wash us clean from our sins; and pour into our hearts the wisdom from above that is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere. O Lord, hear; O Lord, forgive; O Lord, pay attention and act. In the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, we pray. Amen.¹

MOMENT FOR SILENT CONFESSION OF PERSONAL SIN
