

PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION

Before partaking of Holy Communion here at Grace, we ask you to carefully review the following statements.

I have been baptized into the name of the one true God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:18-20)

I have been instructed concerning the meaning of Holy Communion, and I understand the vital importance of self-examination prior to coming to the Lord's Supper. (I Corinthians 11:27-28)

I confess that I am a sinner in need of forgiveness. I am sorry for my sins. (I John 1:8-9)

I believe that Jesus Christ, God's Son, is my Savior from sin, death, and the power of the devil. (Ephesians 2:4-5, 8-9)

As far as I know, I am at peace with everyone. I harbor no hatred, bitterness, anger, unforgiveness, hard feelings or vengeance in my heart toward anyone. (Matthew 5:23-24)

By the power of the Holy Spirit, I desire and intend to lead a more godly and Christ-like life, trusting in God's promises and obeying his commands. (Colossians 3:1, 5, 12-14)

If you agree, without reservation, to these statements, you are invited to come to the Lord's Supper. If you cannot honestly affirm one or more of these statements, we request that you refrain from participating in Holy Communion at today's service.
