 - Apostolic team also provides care
 - Pastors care for each other
- 9. Provide pastoral care for para-church leaders
 - An assigned leader provides pastoral care
 - Apostolic team also provides care
 - Para-church leaders care for each other
 - Their local church pastor provides care
- 10. Provide leadership training and equipping
 - Consultations, coaching, and occasional workshops
 - Help with vison development and goal setting

- 11. Provide a leadership training school for leaders and emerging leaders
 - Partnership with Dove Global School
 - Credit transfer options to Elim College and Chesapeake College
- 12. Provide expertise and assistance with pastoral transitions
 - Pastoral search process, pastoral leads
 - Succession planning
- 13. Monthly Tuesday leader's gatherings
 - Worship, peer fellowship, teaching, prayer, prophetic ministry
- 14. Monthly regional pastors cluster meetings for support
 - Led by a regional apostle
- 15. Blessings of being an international network
 - International relationships provide a rich fellowship
 - Foster a passion for world missions in our churches
 - Opportunities for mission trips
- 16. We provide mission opportunities and training
 - Primary focus is Asia and our international network locations
 - Partner with the Gateway Project training center in Thailand
 - Missions Pastor Dwane Reitz is available to resource churches
- 17. Annual conference and international gathering
 - Equipping, encouragement, ministry, international fellowship
- 18. Call pastors to check in and encourage
 - From the apostolic team
- 19. Visit each church at least once a year on a Sunday
 - Provide feedback to the pastor following the visit
- 20. Meet with each elder team once a year along with the pastor
 - Overseeing apostle initiates the meeting
- 21. We promote intergenerational participation and ministry
 - We nurture a culture of honor in working together
- 22. We encourage intercessory prayer and prophetic ministry on various levels
- 23. We provide guidance on church structure, polity, and administration

- 24. Resourcing and releasing 5-fold gifts ministries
 - Begins on the local church level and resourced on the network level
 - Bring in five-fold gifted speakers for impartation
 - Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist. Pastor, Teacher
- 25. We have a goal to provide market-place ministry equipping and support
 - Develop partnerships and offer training and support to business leaders
- 26. We encourage various types of church planting and church styles
 - Provide assessments, coaching, start-up funds
 - Large churches, smaller community churches, house churches
- 27. We provide a summer camp for kids and youth
 - Biblical, Spirit-filled, and fun based camp experience
- 28. The network is connected to an apostolic center church that provides strength, stability, hosting, resourcing, and a centralized office
