Our church is excited to offer interactive Bible-based worship and teaching for Pre-K through 5th Grade.

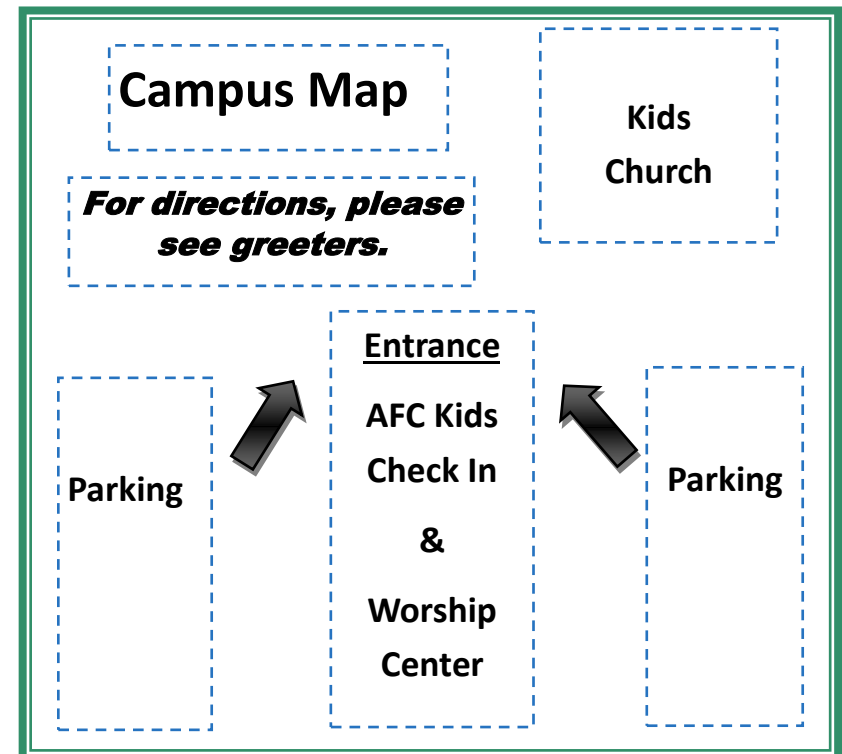
