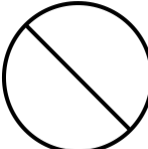


Brooklake Christian School Dress Code Guidelines

Preschool-6th

- On Field Trip days, students are required to wear their Red BCS T-shirt or Sweatshirt with jeans or non-form fitting athletic pants.

Appearance Policy	
	- Only approved attire may be worn on campus during school hours. - Clothing must be modest, neat, clean, and without holes or thread patches. - Student apparel should cover an area from the shoulders to, at minimum, mid-thigh, keeping modesty in mind. - Clothing must fit appropriately, avoiding overly loose or snug options. - Attire must be free of questionable or inappropriate messages. - Hair must be neat, clean, and out of eyes. - No sunglasses, hats, or hoods may be worn indoors. Shirts: BCS apparel, Button-Down or Collared Shirts, Polo, Blouse, Turtleneck *Preschool & Pre-k can wear T-shirts. * (No licensed cartoon or characters) Pants: Khakis or slacks in any solid color. Leggings can only be worn if student's bottoms are covered by skirts, dresses, shirts, sweaters. No athletic pants or sweatpants. (Any print as long as it is not licensed characters or large wordings) Shorts: Khakis or capris (Any print as long as it is not licensed characters or large wordings, mid-thigh or longer) Skirts, Dresses, Jumpers, Biker Shorts: Mid-thigh in length or longer. Leggings, biker shorts, or tights must be worn under dresses and skirts. (Any print as long as it is not licensed characters or large wordings) Shoes: Closed toed and shoes with backs only. - No costumes or heels, we want kids to be able to play on the playground safely. Hair: Only natural colors, hair must be kept neat and cared for.

Free Dress Fridays	

	● Friday's students are allowed to wear casual clothing of their choice that complies with the appearance policy listed above. ● Students may wear appropriate length skirts, dresses, and shorts. Non ripped jeans. ● Casual tops, sweatshirts, and sweaters, no inappropriate language or characters. ● All mid-drifts and chest areas should be covered adequately.
Consequences of Uniform/Dress Code and Appearance Policy Violations	
	● Students are expected to arrive at school properly dressed each day. ● Students out of uniform 3 times will be sent to the office, where staff will contact parents to bring appropriate clothing to school so the child can change. ● Repeated uniform/ dress code violations will be referred to school administration. ● Uniform/ dress code violations will be tracked in FACTS and a notification will be sent home.

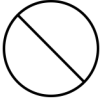

Staff

Appearance Policy	
	● Only approved attire may be worn on campus during school hours. ● Clothing must be modest, neat, clean, and without holes or thread patches. ● Staff apparel should cover an area from the shoulders to, at minimum, mid-thigh, keeping modesty in mind. ● Clothing must fit appropriately, avoiding overly loose or snug options. ● Attire must be free of questionable or inappropriate messages. ● Hair must be neat, clean, and out of eyes. ● No hats, or hoods may be worn indoors. ● Shirts: Button-Down or Collared Shirts, Polo, Blouse, Turtleneck (No licensed cartoon or characters) ● Pants: Khakis or slacks in any solid color. Leggings can only be worn if bottoms are covered by skirts, dresses, shirts, sweaters. Recess staff and PE staff can wear non form fitting athletic pants and or jeans free from rips, tears, distress marks, or holes. ● Shorts: Must be mid-thigh or longer, free of rips, tears, distress marks, or holes. ● Skirts, Dresses, Jumpers, Biker Shorts: Mid-thigh in length or longer. ● Shoes: Shoes with backs only.

Free Dress Fridays	
  	- Friday's staff is allowed to wear casual clothing of their choice that complies with the appearance policy listed above. - Jeans can be worn if they are neat and free of any rips, tears, distress marks, or holes. - Casual tops, sweatshirts, and sweaters, no inappropriate language or characters.
Consequences of Uniform/Dress Code and Appearance Policy Violations	
	- Staff is expected to arrive at school properly dressed each day. - Staff out of uniform will be addressed by the administration.
