Overview

Our Catholic homeschool co-op meets on Friday mornings to pray, learn, socialize and support one another. We meet at St. Gianna Catholic Church in Wentzville, Missouri. The co-op is designed for children from kindergarten through high school with childcare for the younger children to enable the entire family to participate. Everyone's participation is necessary for our co-op to be successful, function smoothly, and keep our tuition as low as possible. Since we are a true co-op and not a drop off educational program, a parent must attend and actively participate on co-op mornings. Grandparents and other family members are welcome to visit any time, but a parent must also be present for children to participate.

High School and Junior High Students

Courses for junior high and high school students will vary each year according to the needs of the families involved. These courses often include Religion, Literature, Fine Arts, or other electives.

Children gather in an "atrium," a room prepared for them, which contains simple yet beautiful materials they use to help them absorb the most essential proclamations of the Catholic faith.
