We are a community of families who have chosen to raise our children in the Catholic faith in union with the Magisterium of the Catholic Church. We have come together as a community to pray and grow in our faith, to support one another in our homeschool efforts, and to learn in an environment of love and respect for each other.

About our co-op

Our Catholic co-op meets Wednesdays from 8:45-3:15 at St. Gianna Catholic Church in Wentzville, MO. We currently have classes for pre-school through high school aged students, as well as a nursery for younger siblings. Parental participation is necessary for our co-op to be successful, especially for our younger grades.

Junior co-op (grades pre-k through 5)

Junior co-op meets from 8:45-12:00. We primarily serve as an enrichment program, offering a religion class with hands on activities and various classes depending on grade and interest. Some classes offered in the past have included science, art, letter recognition, Lego STEM, PE, sign language, and reading. Some classes, such as violin and ballet, are offered for an extra fee if there is continued interest. We evaluate our classes annually and adjust as needed. We have time each week set aside for socialization and free play, as well as parties that coincide with the liturgical season.

Senior co-op (grades 6-12)

Senior co-op meets from 8:45-3:15 with a 1 hour lunch break at noon. We offer classes for both enrichment and academic credit. Seeing that we only meet once a week, most of our academic classes require work outside of the classroom. Some classes offered in the past have included Human Anatomy, Biology, Jr and Sr high school level math, U.S History, World History, Literature, Homesteading, Sewing, Speech, and Kitchen Skills. We evaluate our classes annually and adjust based on need and available teachers.
