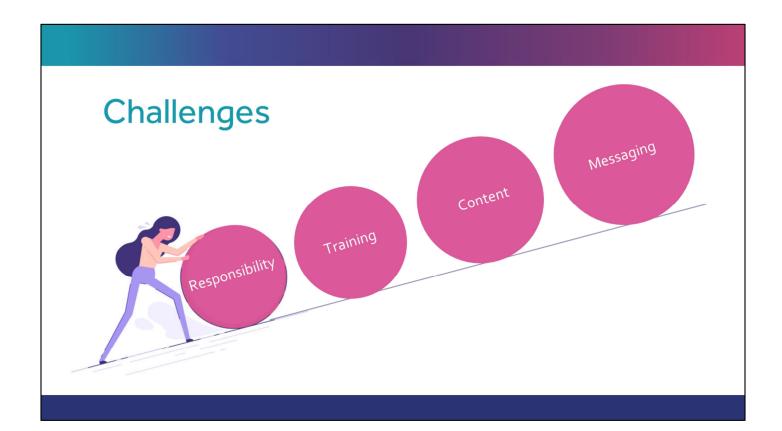

Remember that the club roadmap guides us all toward reaching our goals. This reference will always be there to remind you of the specific goals we are marching toward.

So, when I talk about nimble membership campaigns know that our campaigns will be targeting these outcomes that we're all striving to reach.

### 1. Maintain 85% or better retention rate.

This has been our baseline retention rate for over 20 years and we're so proud that our organization was able to maintain this retention rate throughout the global pandemic. We will continue to focus on our loyal membership base and provide an engaging member experience as we hold this retention goal.

### 2. Add new members to your club.

We're focusing on membership recruitment and growth and we're asking each club to add new members this year.



To **increase new clubs,** we will charter and mentor new clubs this year.

Here on the islands, we have so many opportunities to charter new clubs. Let's do it!
